### **NOTICE OF RACE**

The Lake Wellington Yacht Club Inc invites entries for its **2019-2020 Club Racing Season**. The season commences on 6th Oct 2019 with a safety briefing and concludes on the 5th April 2020.

This Notice of Race covers all club events detailed in the 2019-2020 LWYC Sailing Instructions excluding the Marlay Point Overnight Yacht Race, the Eastern Region Interclub Regatta and any event scheduled in conjunction with another club not contested on Lake Wellington.

#### **\*1 Rules**

The **2019-2020 Club Racing Season** will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, 2017 to 2020, the prescriptions and special regulations of the AYF, the rules of the individual class(es), (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

Club Races for trailer sailors will be either Category 7 or 5 as detailed in the LWYC Sailing Instructions. Off the beach boats will comply with the appropriate safety requirements

#### **\*2 Alterations of Class Rules**

#### **\*3 Alterations of Racing Rules**

The racing rules will be modified in accordance with rule 86 as follows:

3.1 Special Regulation 3.23 (b) will be altered to become mandatory for Cat 7.

3.24 Yachts carrying Radios during the **Club Racing Season** shall have them turned on while racing.

#### **4 Eligibility and Entry**

4.1 The **Club Racing Season** is open to all sailing boats whose owners are financial members of the LWYC Inc. All crews must also be members. Visiting members of other affiliated clubs are eligible to race for a maximum of three races after which they must join the LWYC.
